1. In line with Republic Act 10533 or the Enhanced Basic Education Act of 2013, section 7a which provides for the training of current DepEd teachers to meet the content and performance standards of the K to 12 Curriculum, this Office will conduct a Division Training of Teachers on the Adept Development on Appropriate Pedagogies (ADAPT) in Teaching Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao Stage 2) on December 10-11, 2019. The venue shall be announced later.
2. This training aims to:
 - a. Help teachers gain the necessary appropriate and up to date content knowledge int teaching ESP Grades 4.5.& 6;
 - b. Help teachers acquire the instructional strategies and pedagogical skills relevant in teaching ESP
