1. Background and Objectives

In celebration of the 78th *Araw ng Kagitingan* and Philippine Veterans Week, the Department of Education (DepEd), Philippine Veterans Affairs Office (PVAO) and the Department of National Defense (DND) are sponsoring a Creative Painting Contest.

The contest objectives are to increase awareness of Historical Places in the Philippines during World War II where veterans fought for the country and sacrificed lives, and to remember the reasons why we experience freedom up to this day.

2. Participants

The contest is open to all Grades 7, 8, 9 and 10 students enrolled in any public and private secondary schools nationwide. The school should be duly recognized by the Department of Education.

3. Theme

The theme of this year's **ARAW NG KAGITINGAN AND PHILIPPINE VETERANS WEEK** is **"PAMANANG KALAYAAN NG MGA BETERANO: ISABUHAY AT PAGYAMANIN NG LAHING PILIPINO."**

4. Entry Specification

Only entries submitted in correct and complete specifications and formats will be considered as official entries. Please take note of the following requirements to ensure that your entry satisfies the specifications of the contest:

- a. The painting should be in 15"x20" illustration board. The following details including a typewritten message (1 or 2 sentences, in Filipino or in English) must be printed on a ½ A-4 size bond paper and be posted at the back of the painting:

- b. The Philippine Flag should not be used as background of the painting. If used as part, it should be placed in a conspicuous place to show its importance to the art work. (Please refer to Sec. 39 - Prohibited Acts of RA 8491.)

c. Composition	25%
d. Visual Impact	20%

NATIONAL ESSAY WRITING CONTEST**

1. Background and Objective

In celebration of the 78th *Araw ng Kagitingan* and Philippine Veterans Week, the Department of Education (DepEd) and the Department of National Defense (DND) are sponsoring an Essay Writing Contest.

The contest objective is to increase awareness of the *Araw ng Kagitingan* as a shining moment of courage and commitment to freedom by our WWII veterans.

2. Participants

The contest is open to all Grades 7, 8, 9 and 10 students enrolled in any public and private secondary schools nationwide. The school should be duly recognized by the Department of Education.

Previous champions in this National Essay Writing Contest are not allowed to join.

3. Theme

The theme of this year's competition is **"PAMANANG KALAYAAN NG MGA BETERANO: ISABUHAY AT PAGYAMANIN NG LAHING PILIPINO."**

4. Content

The entry must be a true to life story of the veteran/s (alive or deceased). The story teller must be his/her relative up to the 4th degree of consanguinity.

5. Entry Specification

The essay must be crafted from the story of the veteran/s. It should:

- a. be written in Filipino
- b. be typewritten in an A-4 size bond paper
- c. have single line spacing
- d. have one (1) inch margin on both sides
- e. use Times New Roman, font size 12
- f. have a minimum of 3 pages and a maximum of 4 pages, also at the end of the essay, the names, address, telephone number/s (if any) of the veteran interviewed should be included.

6. Criteria

a. Substance and Originality	50%
b. Style and Language	30%
c. Organization	20%
Total	100%

7. Submission

All entries must be submitted to the Regional Special Events Coordinator **not later than March 16, 2020 (Wednesday)**. The best entry will then be sent to the DepEd Central Office not later than **March 20, 2020 (Friday)**. Judging will begin promptly at **9:00 am on March 23 to 24, 2020 (Monday & Tuesday)**. Each entry must be accompanied by the following requirements:

- a. A certification from the principal that the contestant is enrolled in the current School Year (SY 2019-2020);
- b. Scanned image of the student and the principal, school ID or any valid ID; and
- c. Accomplished entry form.

ORATORICAL CONTEST**

Subject to such changes as may be determined appropriate, the following general rules shall apply:

1. Participants

The contest is open to all Grades 7, 8, 9 and 10 students enrolled in any public and private secondary schools nationwide. The school should be duly recognized by the Department of Education.

Previous champions in this Oratorical Contest are not allowed to join.

2. Theme and Content

The oratorical piece must be in Filipino, original, never been published, and expounding on the theme: **"PAMANANG KALAYAAN NG MGA BETERANO: ISABUHAY AT PAGYAMANIN NG LAHING PILIPINO."**

The piece must be delivered for a minimum of seven(7) minutes and a maximum of 10 minutes.

The oration **SHOULD NOT**, in whole or in part, whether expressly or impliedly, offend any race, religious freedom, nor should it be against the laws of environment, honor and dignity, or the moral standards of Filipinos.

3. Criteria

a. Content	Sincerity, originality and relevance to the theme	50%
b. Delivery	Posture, gesture, eye contact, facial expression, Pronunciation, volume and mastery	40%
c. Persuasion and Stage Presence		10%
Total		100%

4. Submission

All contestants shall submit four (4) copies of their oratorical piece to the External Partnerships Service-Special Events Unit (EPS-SEU) upon their arrival at the hotel.

5. In case the regional winner could not attend, the second prize winner will automatically represent the region in the National Competition. Concerned parties should notify EPS-SEU in case of replacement, **five days before the grand finals.**

6. Attire

During the final competition, the contestants shall wear the appropriate attire:

- Boys - Barong
- Girls - Simple Filipiniana Dress

7. Determination and Announcement of Winners

The contestant who will get the highest points shall be considered as the National Champion, the contestant with the second highest points shall be declared as the first runner-up, and the contestant with the third highest score shall be declared as the second runner-up.

Winners will be announced after the final competition on **April 5, 2020** at _____(TBA) and will be awarded at Mt. Samat Shrine, Bataan on **April 6, 2020**.

8. Logistics

Board and lodging (three days and two nights), land and air travel (tickets) of the participants (1 contestant and 1 coach) shall be charged against Veterans Federation of the Philippines (VFP) fund subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations

Other travel expenses outside the coverage of VFP (transportation, per diem, and other incidental expenses) of the contestants and coaches during the awarding ceremonies shall be charged against local funds or sourced from NGOs, municipality/city funds and/or civic spirited clubs and organizations subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

10. Prizes

The Organizing Committee shall make suitable arrangements to ensure the provisions of the prizes for the competition.

11. Copyright

The concerned agencies have the right to publish the selected contest pieces and the right to determine other matters not included under the rules.

12. The decision of the Board of Judges is final, non-appealable and irrevocable.
