1. To strengthen the full implementation of the Continuous Improvement (CI) Program and in preparation for the Regional Search for the Outstanding Division CI Implementer for CY 2020 as stipulated in Regional Memorandum No. 243, the Division Office through the Schools Governance and Operation Division (SGOD) will launch a Division Search for the Outstanding School CI Implementer for CY 2020.

3. The Schools shall submit their documents based on the attached criteria with Means of Verification (MOVs) in hard copy endorsed by the Public Schools District Supervisor (PSDS) and submit the same to the SGOD office on or before September 15, 2020.
4. The top three (3) identified schools/sections shall undergo a face-to-face or online validation with the Regional Validation Committee. The schedule of the validation, declaration and awarding of winners shall be announced later.
5. The Public Schools District Supervisors (PSDS) and the CI coaches are advised to provide the necessary technical assistance to their assigned CI schools.

CRITERIA FOR OUTSTANDING SCHOOL CI IMPLEMENTERS
