1. GSIS is pleased to announce that it offers P10, 000. 00 educational subsidy to 10, 000 children and dependents of its low-income members through the GSIS Educational Subsidy Program (GESP) in support to the social development policy of President Rodrigo R. Duterte to provide wider access to quality college education to the marginalized section as enshrined in RA No. 10931 or the 2017 Universal Access to Quality Tertiary Education which provides free tuition and miscellaneous fees to enrollees of state colleges and universities;

2. This is open to all active GSIS members with permanent employment status who are occupying salary grade 24 and below; with updated GSIS premium payments and no unpaid or underpaid loan amortizations for more than three months for the duration of the grant, and have college student dependents in any year level who have been accepted in or taking up any four-or five-year course in any university or college recognized by the CHED.

3. The grantees will continue to receive educational subsidy until they finish their college course for as long as they meet the scholastic requirement of 80% general weighted average with no failing grade or incomplete mark.

4. Interested members may apply by submitting the GESP application forms that may be downloaded from the GSIS website (www.gsis.gov.ph), dependent's birth certificate issued by the Philippine Statistics Authority and certificate of employment of the member and/or certified true copy of the service record duly signed by the Agency Authorized Officer of the member's employer.
