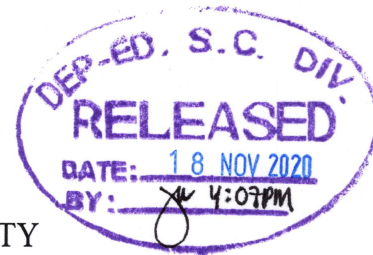

Mechanics/Criteria:

A. Video-making Contest

1. Only 1 entry per Division Office
2. Student/s from either elementary or secondary school
3. Video may also involve family or household members
4. Video must only run for a maximum of 7 minutes to include intros, credits, etc.
5. Video must show the various activities of the student/s/families that depict climate action and/or disaster resilience amidst the new normal
6. Videos must be original and have not been an entry to any other contests of the same concept.
7. Video must be saved in .mp4 format with title format DIVISION NAME_videoentry
8. Together with the video is a .pdf format about the background/summary about the video, name of the video-maker, grade level and school name, video participants (if with family group), and the date and place where the video was taken.
9. Video should also show safety measures like wearing of face mask/shield, etc. esp. if with family members involved.
10. Entries must be endorsed and submitted to the RO on November 23, 2020 until 5:00pm via e-mail add: megnon.beldad@deped.gov.ph. Inform the Secretariat of the submitted entry via cp no. 0910-472-3654.
11. Judges will choose the top 3 winning entries to be shown on Nov. 26, 2020 during the 2020 DRRM Year-end PIR.
12. RO will issue a regional bulletin for the official result of the contest.
13. Cash Prizes shall be sent through nearest pera padala available within the area of the winners. Sen-out fees shall be deducted from the cash prizes and certificates will be sent through the Division Coordinator of the winning division.
14. All entries of the competition shall be the property of DepEd Caraga to use for EIC purposes.
15. Decision of the judges is final and irrevocable.

B. Comic-making Contest

1. Only 1 entry per Division Office
2. Open to student/s from either elementary or secondary school (private or public)
3. Comic must be done by one person only
4. Art and/or storyline must be relevant to the activity
5. Artwork must be the original work of the student entering the contest. Photographs can only be used as guidelines.
6. Language may be in Filipino, English or combination
7. Entries must be hand-drawn in vertical/horizontal Cartolina paper, minimum of 4/maximum of 6 frames with title of the comic printed anywhere in the page.
8. Entries may use one or a combination of crayons, watercolors, oil pastel, pen markers, color pens or charcoal
9. Drawings must be clear and visible enough to be easily read.
10. Students may submit previously created artwork if it has not been published elsewhere.
11. Contest entries cannot be obscene, indecent, or contain profanities, excessive violence or gore. Entries must be suitable for all ages and for replication/display.
12. There must be a recorded video of the student creating the comic and must be saved in any quality video format. Fast motion is preferred but not necessary.
13. Picture of the final comic output must be saved in .jpeg format and be sent together with the video. E-mailed entries must have title format: DIVISION NAME_comicentry.
14. Entries must be endorsed and submitted to the RO on November 23, 2020 until 5:00pm via e-mail add: megnon.beldad@deped.gov.ph. Inform the Secretariat of the submitted entry via cp no. 0910-472-3654 via text message or call.
15. Judges will choose the top 3 winning entries to be shown on Nov. 26, 2020 during the 2020 DRRM Year-end PIR.
16. RO will issue a regional bulletin for the official result of the contest.
17. Cash Prizes shall be sent through the nearest pera padala available within the area of the winners. Sen-out fees shall be deducted from the cash prizes and certificates will be sent through the Division Coordinator of the winning division.
18. All entries of the competition shall be the property of DepEd Caraga to use for EIC purposes.
