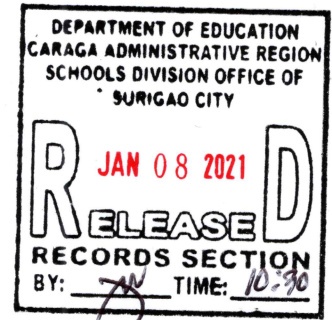

Dear Dr. Galanida,

Security Bank Foundation, Inc., in partnership with Knowledge Channel Foundation, Inc. (KCFI) and Ateneo De Manila University, produced twenty (20) educational videos focusing on the four (4) most essential learning competencies (MELCs) in English Reading as our contribution in helping education stakeholders cope with the new normal. Post-pandemic, we also see these videos as effective tools for the teachers to deliver interactive delivery of lessons inside classrooms.

The videos were produced following the Department of Education (DepEd) daily lesson guides. Focus group discussions among select teachers and students of our adopted schools were also conducted to ensure the quality and relevance of the videos. We selected English Reading MELCs as the subject matter of the videos to support DepEd in addressing the findings of 2018 Programme for International Student Assessment (PISA).

The videos focus on the following MELCs (five 15-minute videos per MELC):

- Grade 1 – Predict possible ending of story
- Grade 3 – Make inferences and draw conclusions based on texts
- Grade 3 – Interpret simple graphs, tables and pictographs
- Grade 5 – Infer the meaning of unfamiliar words

These videos will be launched on a staggered delivery from January to May 2021 aligning with the expected appearance of the covered MELCs in the DepEd academic calendar. The videos will be made available for free to everyone through the following mediums:

- Television – Knowledge Channel in Cable Providers and A2Z Free TV Channel
- Online – Security Bank, Knowledge Channel, and Ateneo Websites, Facebook Pages and Youtube Channels
- Offline – Portable Media Libraries of Schools with Knowledge Channel TVs

We will be also organizing three schedules of free virtual teachers' trainings to launch the videos and provide participants with a walkthrough on how they can integrate the videos in both distance and face-to-face mode of learning deliveries. The training will also talk about educational technology as a tool for pedagogy.

While MELCs cover specific grade levels, the training is open to all Elementary English teachers and other interested education stakeholders.
