

HOW TO APPLY?

Step 1: The proponent/s should prepare the following:

- a. Complete Name/s, Titles, Institutional Affiliations
- b.CV of proponent and co-proponent/s
- c. Endorsement of his/her institution
- d. Institutional Profile
- c. Other requirements for proponents from the private sector/ non-government organizations:
 - SEC registration / [] Cooperative Development Authority
 (CDA) registration certificate
 - Latest documents of incorporations
 - Co-signers statement (if applicable)
 - Copy of latest Income Tax Return and tax clearance
 - Mayor's permit where the business is located
- Audited Financial Statements for the past three (3)
- Other eligibility and technical documents / requirements (Section 53.1 IRR of RA 9184 and; GPPB Resolution No. 25-2013, Section 6.5 Guidelines on NGO participation in Public Procurement)





HOW TO APPLY?

Step 2: Prepare a Letter of Intent (addressed to the DOST Regional Director of the region you belong)

Step 3: Prepare a Full-blown Proposal (refer to the DOST GIA Forms 2A and 2B)

Step 4: Accomplish Gender and Development Form

Step 5: Accomplish SDG Scorecard Form

Step 6: Submit the Full-Blown Proposal in word format (editable) and the complete requirements to your nearest DOST Regional Office starting December 10, 2020 until January 15, 2021. Below is the contact details of the DOST Regional Offices of Mindanao Cluster I:
