

NATIONAL ROBOTICS COMPETITION-ONLINE

The Pinoy Robot Games (PRG) will launch its National Robotics Competition-Online. Participants may start performing the challenges and solving problems. Participants may begin submitting their entries on April 10, 2021. All entries are weekly evaluated and ranked until the culminating date of May 15, 2021.

There will be 12 events. All are new. Instead of completed Robotics and Artificial Intelligence Project, one event is the "Great RIM Ideas". In this event, participants will propose a solution to any of the United Nation's Sustainable Development Goals categories. No actual device is needed. PRG is offering one free registration to the event "Great RIM Ideas". The entry must have the endorsement coming from the Regional Office.
