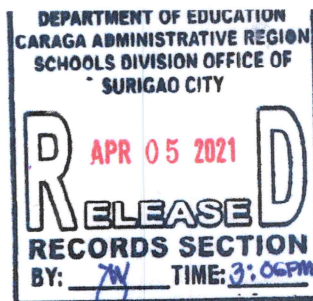

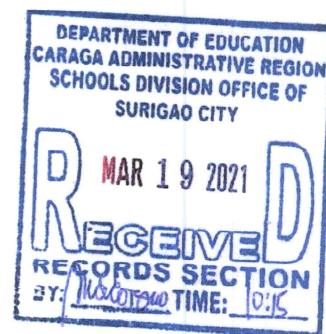

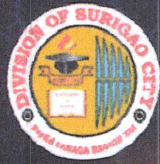

HERITAGE MONTH 2021

THEME: "Victory and Humanity: Upholding Filipino Heritage and Identity"

ELIGIBILITY

- The contest is open to **Elementary Schools** representing the 10 Districts of the Schools Division of Surigao City.
- All Districts are required to send **one (1) entry only** with an original composition. **COMPOSER** maybe a **teacher or pupils or both** but the **INTERPRETER** of the song must be a pupil ages **9-12 years old**.
- For the purpose of the competition, submitted song entry in video must have both lyrics and music. All must be original and unpublished.

SUBMISSION POLICY

- The purpose of the competition is to foster skills and discover new Surigaonon talents among children in singing and in songwriting of original and unpublished material. The City Tourism Office disclaims any liability that may arise from the submission, performance and promotion of the entries. However, materials submitted will not be returned and the City Tourism Office reserves the right to dispose all submitted materials.

CONTEST MATERIAL

- Composition must be **PURELY in SURIGAONON** dialect.
- Accompaniment will be either guitar or piano. Other instruments maybe allowed (band set, flute, beatbox, etc) depending on the chosen theme by the composer.
- Entry must be 3 – 5 minutes only in **Video MP4 Format**. 10 points will be deducted if less or excess of time.
- Soft copy of the composition/lyrics must also be submitted.

WINNER SELECTION, PRIZES

- Online judges will pre-judge the submitted video song entry using the criteria for judging (separate sheet). All entries will be posted in our **CITY TOURISM OFFICE FB OFFICIAL PAGE** for the whole duration of month of May. The following winners will be declared:

CRITERIA FOR JUDGING

SONG STRUCTURE AND COMPOSITION (20%)

- The song has a clear theme or cohesive idea.
- The song has clearly identifiable sections, verse, chorus, etc.
- The song is between 3-5 minutes only.

LYRICS (25%)

- **MUST** be SURIGAONON
- The lyrics evoke an emotional response from the listener
- The lyrics are singable and memorable
- The lyrics have an identifiable rhyme scheme or pattern

MUSIC AND MELODY (15%)

- The music and melody adds to the emotional impact of the song.
- The music keeps the listener interested and engaged.
- The music and lyrics fit together in cohesive way.

ORIGINALITY/co(20%)

- The song expresses the theme in a new or fresh way.
- The song is memorable
- The song has commercial potential.

DELIVERY AND INTERPRETATION (20%)

- The singer has internalized and competently delivered the song
- The singer is able to convey the message of the song
- The singer's expression is cohesive with the message of the song

GRAND TOTAL 100%

Ranking method will be used to determine the major winners.

- Representatives should provide their own painting materials and stand (TRIPAD 5.5' High) for the exhibit.
- Painting size is 20" x 25" (standard size canvass).
