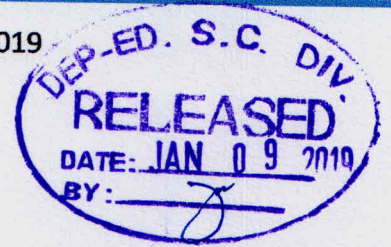

After the serial conduct of Stage 2 (Administration of the Phil-IRI Graded Passages (Pre-Test), and Stage 3 (Provision of the Specialized Instruction) to learners needing reading intervention following the guidelines stipulated in DepEd Order No. 014, s, 2018 which is the Policy Guidelines on the Administration of the Revised Philippine Informal Reading Inventory (Phil-IRI), the field is hereby advised of the conduct of the **STAGE 4-THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE PHIL-IRI GRADED PASSAGES (POST TEST) AND CONSULTATIVE MEETING OF DISTRICT READING COORDINATORS AND REORIENTATION ON THE USE OF THE STAGE 4 - CONTEXTUALIZED PHIL-IRI FORMS** at 4:00 PM to 5: PM on January 10, 2019 at the Function Hall, 3rd Floor of this SDO, Surigao City.
2. As the manual suggests, English will cater to Grades 4, 5 and 6 only while Filipino to Grades 3, 4, 5 & 6; however, to reiterate the initiative of this Division, Grade 7 shall be included in this assessment. Articles for Grade 7 are included in the 2018 version of the new Phil-IRI Manual.
3. All schools should fill out the required data using the contextualized forms attached herein for consolidation and reporting purposes.
4. This time, District Offices are responsible to **CONSOLIDATE** all school reports on these data, and submit copies of same to this Office specifically to the Office of the Chief of the Curriculum Implementation Division, CID Chief Dr. Carlo P. Tantoy.
5. All District Reading Coordinators are requested to join the consultative meeting and reinforcement orientation on January 11, 2019, 4:00 PM to 5 PM at the 3rd Floor of this Division's office.
