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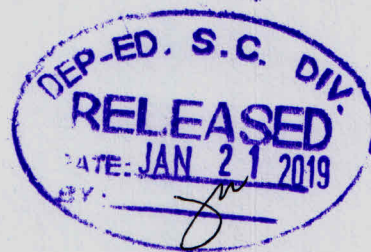

In reference to Regional Memorandum No. 016, s. 2019, the Regional Office through the Quality Assurance Division reminds all concerned that documentary requirements, for the *issuance of Special Orders for the approval of the eligibility for graduation from Senior High School of Grade 12 learners enrolled in private schools/colleges and technical-vocational institutions for SY 2018-2019*, should be submitted on or before March 18, 2019.

2. In connection to the set deadline of the Regional Office, this Division requests all private schools/ colleges and technical- vocational institutions in Surigao City with graduating Grade 12 learners to submit the complete documentary requirements to the School Management, Monitoring and Evaluation (SMME) Section of the Schools Governance and Operations Division (SGOD) on or before **March 4, 2019**.

3. Attached herewith is the above referred Regional Memorandum for the *list of the documentary requirements, important guidelines for the said issuance and the standardized forms to use* in preparation for ISO:9001:2015 certification of DepEd Regional Office. Prescribed format and other specifications in filling up the form must be strictly observed (refer to item # 6 of the RM).

4. Wide dissemination and compliance of this Memorandum is desired.

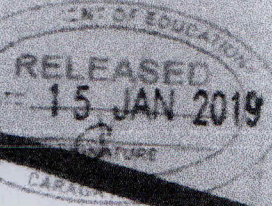

**DOCUMENTARY REQUIREMENTS FOR ISSUANCE OF SPECIAL ORDERS FOR THE APPROVAL
OF THE ELIGIBILITY FOR GRADUATION FROM SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL OF GRADE 12
LEARNERS ENROLLED IN PRIVATE SCHOOLS/COLLEGES AND
TECHNICAL-VOCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS, SY: 2018-2019**

This Region
1. The Regional Office through the Quality Assurance Division is responsible to issue special orders to schools that were issued provisional permits to operate in SY: 2016-2017 and SY: 2017-2018 for the graduation of qualified Grade 12 learners.
 2. The issuance of special orders shall follow the same guidelines stipulated in DepEd Order No. 88, s. 2010, or the Revised Manual of Regulations for Private Schools in Basic Education, except for the timeline of application for special orders.
 3. Applications for special orders of qualified Grade 12 Learners for SY: 2018-2019 shall be filed by the school through the schools division office (SDO) at least 15 calendar days before the end of the current academic year. In DepEd Order No. 25, s. 2018, SY: 2018-2019 shall end on Friday, April 5, 2019. Thus, the private schools/colleges and TVIs shall submit the documents on or before March 18, 2019.
 4. In DepEd Order No. 10, s. 2018, issuance of special orders is applicable only for private schools/colleges and Technical Vocational Institutions and not for State/Local Universities and Colleges.
 5. The school's application for Special Order for Graduation Form (Form 9) must be supported with the following documentary requirements:
 - a. Endorsement from the Schools Division Superintendent;
 - b. Accomplished Special Order for Graduation Form (Form 9);
 - c. Letter of Recommendation from the School Registrar/ School Principal or Administrator/School Committee for Checking of Documents on the Candidates for graduation of the particular school year;
 - d. Certified True Copy of the Student's Permanent Record (SF10-JHS) of the last school attended;
 - e. Certified True Copy of the Student's Permanent Record (SF10-SHS) of the school attended;

- f. Certified True Copy of the Student's Permanent Record (SF10-SHS) of the latter school, if the student is a transferee from another school.
- g. Certification from the School Registrar/School Principal, if the student is taking summer classes to another school or a cross enrollee of another school;
- h. Accomplished Student Evaluation Form which contains the names of all Student-Recipients of Certificates of Diploma (specify the subjects earned – applied, core, specialized, elective, and institutional subjects – and specify SHS Program Track/Strand/Specialization and NC for the TVL Track – if done) with Signature of the School Registrar, Principal, Division Supervisor-in-charge of Private Schools, Chief – CID, and Schools Division Superintendent; and
- i. Verified copy of the original NSO/PSA Birth Certificate from the School Registrar/School Head or Certified True Copy of the NSO/PSA Birth Certificate from the National Statistics Office for Filipino Citizen Students, if the student is not a Filipino Citizen, submit copies of the birth certificate from a foreign country, alien certification of registration and certification from the Bureau of Immigration.

6. The Regional Office is standardizing its forms in preparation for ISO: 9001:2015 certification, thus, item 4.b, and 4.h shall be encoded in A4 size Cream Color Canon Paper, font style of Calibri, and font size of 11. The said documents shall list the name of the candidate (s) for graduation and alphabetically arranged (LAST NAME, First Name, and Middle Name) regardless of Track/Strand/Specialization, gender of the candidate(s), month and year of graduation and the number of students (20 students only) listed in 4.b and 4.h forms. It must be reproduced in three (3) copies for the school, SDO, and RO. All other supporting documents must be arranged and reproduced in one (1) copy according to the names of students listed in the Special Order for Graduation Form (Form 9) and Accomplished Students Evaluation Form.

7. The Regional Office shall process and issue the special orders for graduation or send deficiency notices not later than thirty (30) days after the end of each school term.

8. Schools must comply with deficiency notices within one (1) month after receipt thereof. DepEd RO shall process corrected deficiencies and issue the corresponding Special Order within fifteen (15) days after receipt thereof.

9. Schools shall release the Special Order to the students not later than forty-five (45) days after the end of the school term, except in cases of students with financial obligations.
