1. Relevant to the provisions stipulated in **DepEd MEMORANDUM No. 090 s. 2019** this office hereby announce the conduct of the **3RD NATIONAL STORYBOOK WRITING COMPETITION**.
2. The competition aims to attain the following:
 - a. Select and award the best storybooks originally developed by teachers for the Kindergarten to Grade 3 Levels;
 - b. Recognize the skills and competencies of teachers in writing and illustrating stories for children; and
 - c. Collect storybooks for uploading to the Learning Resources Portal.
3. The competition is open to all DepEd School Teachers with Permanent employment status. The Minimum Qualifications are specified in Enclosure No. 1 par. III of the aforementioned DepEd Memorandum.
4. Any entry found to have been copied or plagiarized shall be automatically disqualified.
5. The decision of the board of judges is final and irrevocable.

8. Each Public School District is requested to send four (4) teachers each representing one (1) of the following grade levels: Kindergarten, Grade 1, Grade 2, and Grade 3, subject to the discretion of the District Supervisor.
