Pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 28 dated September 2, 1986 and Presidential Proclamation No. 264 dated September 23, 2002 declaring September as the National Science Club Month (NSCM), the Schools Division of Surigao City shall celebrate the 2019 National Science Club Month from September 1 to 30, 2019.
2. This year's theme, **"Reinventing the Future: Advancing Communities through Science, Technology and Innovations"**. This year's celebration aims to:
