



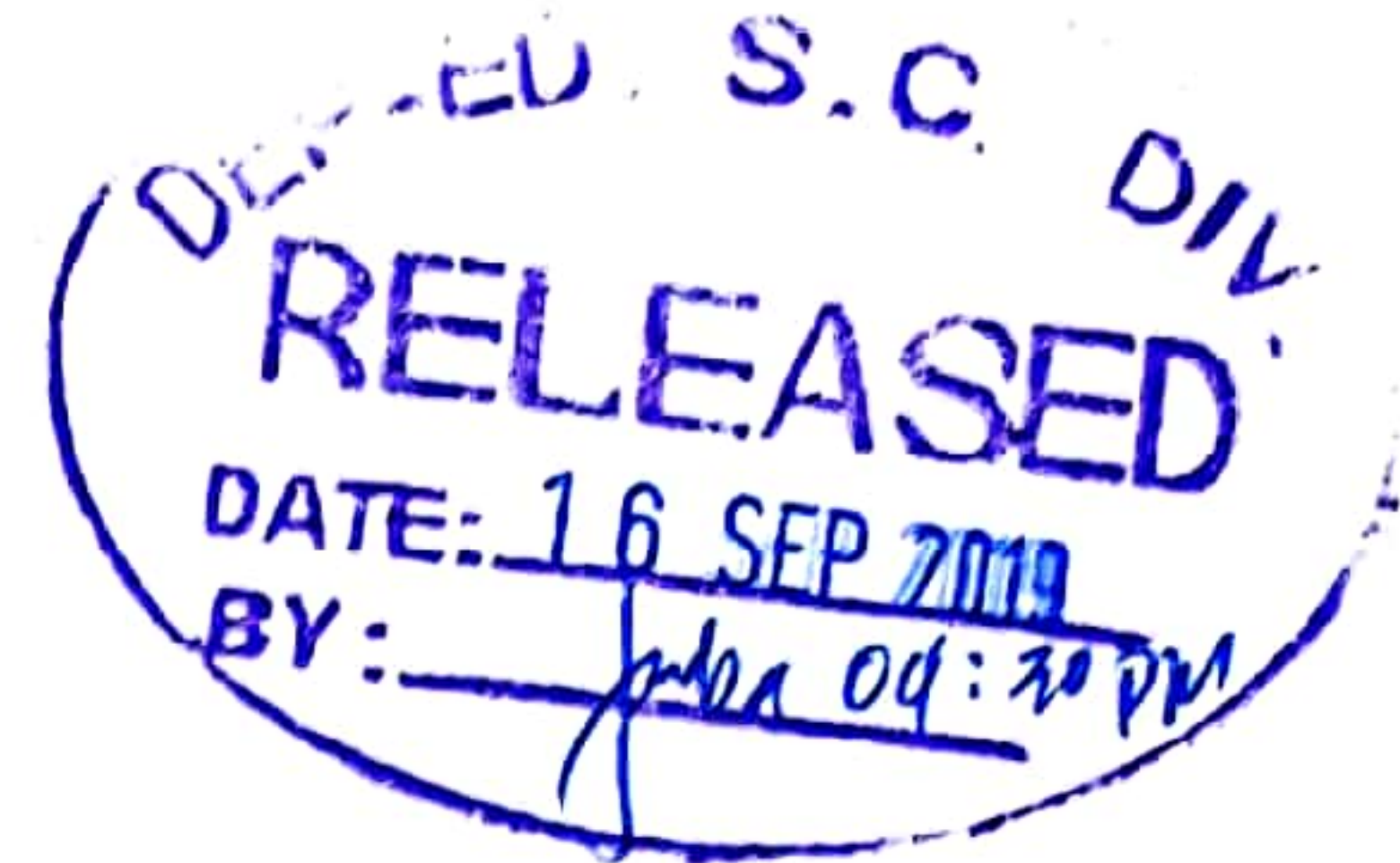

1. Per unnumbered Regional Advisory released on September 5, 2019, re: Participation in the World Food Day of the Department of Agriculture with the theme "Our actions are our Future. # Healthy diets for a # Zero Hunger World". As part of the celebration, the Department of Agriculture will conduct a Poster making contest on September 26, 2019.
2. In consonance with this, the field is hereby informed that the Division On-The-Spot Poster Making Contest will be conducted on September 19, 2019 at 2:00 PM at Surigao City Central Elementary School (SuCCES), Surigao City.
3. Each District shall send one participant.
4. Attached is the mechanics of the said contest for your reference and guidance.
5. Immediate and widest dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.

2019 World Food Day On-the-Spot Poster Making Contest Rules and Criteria

1. The contest is open to all Grades 4 to 6 elementary pupils enrolled in any public and DepEd-accredited private elementary schools nationwide. Previous national winners are disqualified to join at any level of this contest.
2. The poster shall be an original creation of eligible participants, depicting the central theme of the World Food Day 2019 celebration, "Our Actions are our Future. # Healthy diets for a #Zero Hunger world."
3. The poster making contest shall be conducted on-the-spot at the division level.
4. Each contestant shall have one (1) coach.
5. Each district shall have one (1) participant.
6. Each Contestants must bring the following materials:
 - A. illustration Board (20" x 30")
 - B. eight (8) color oil pastel (i.e. red, orange, yellow, green, blue, violet, brown, black) and
 - C. pentel pen
7. The poster should be an original creation of the contestant depicting the given theme of the contest, which will be written outside, and not incorporated in the artwork. Contestants who will not follow instructions will automatically be disqualified.
8. Judging shall immediately commence after all entries have been submitted. Coaches and participants will not be allowed to enter the contest venue while evaluation of the Board of Judges is on-going.
9. The decision of the BOJ shall be final and irrevocable. However, if the winner has been proven committing any misconduct (i.e. plagiarism, or any form of cheating the title), the certificate will be withdrawn.
10. First place winner shall be the official entry of the division during the regional poster making contest on September 26, 2019. (venue to be announced later)
11. Description of the poster entry must be written at the back of the poster with the name of the pupil, name of the coach, school and district.
12. The Best Three (3) Posters shall be selected as Division Winners based on the following criteria:
 - a. Creativity and presentation40%
 - b. Relevance to the theme----- 40%
 - c. Originality ----- 20%
 - Total ----- 100%**
