2019 PATROL (Boy Scouts) and CREW (Senior Scouts) Leaders Training Course

1. In consonance with the mission and vision of the Boy Scout of the Philippines of enhancing leadership, life skills and citizenship training of the young boys, and in adherence Council Memorandum No. 12, s. 2019, the simultaneous conduct of the **Patrol Leaders and Crew Leaders Training Course for Surigao City Division** will be held on **September 13-15, 2019 at Margarita Central Elementary School.**
2. Considering the significance of this Scouting Activity, and the opportunity for our boys in our division, each district shall send a minimum of Sixteen (16) Boy Scouts coming from barangay elementary schools and at least Eight (8) Senior Scouts per secondary school, for small secondary schools, clustering can be done. Private schools are also encouraged to participate.

School and District BSP coordinators are advised to submit the list of their participants three (3) days before the start of the BSP training at the BSP Office give the council enough time for the preparations of individual kits and training materials.

3. A training fee of Two Hundred Fifty Pesos (250.00) shall be charged each participant to cover the training handouts, certificates, training materials and other administrative expenses. Participants shall bring their own sleeping gears, firewood, food probations, cooking and eating gears for the duration. Transportation to and from the venue shall be the responsibility of every participant.
4. The arrival of delegates will be on September 13, 2019 at 4:30 pm at the identified venues. The Opening Program will start at 6:00 pm at the covered court of the host school.
5. The training will be handled by all Woodbadgers of Surigao City Division. An urgent meeting for speakers shall be done on September 11, 2019 2:00 pm at the division office. Assignment of topics and committees is the main concern of the meeting.
6. All teachers who will be serving as resource speakers/facilitators and adult leaders shall be given two (2) days service credits, while non-teaching personnel shall be given Compensatory Time-Off (CTO) credits per joint circular No.2, s. 2004 of the CSC and DBM.
7. Immediate dissemination of and strict compliance with this memorandum is highly desired.
