



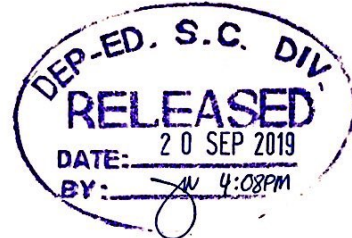

1. The Department of Health Center for Health Development – Caraga thru the City Health Office will conduct the Lymphatic Filariasis Transmission Assessment Survey to validate/evaluate our City to become “Free Filaria City”.


