1. To ensure the continuity of the implementation of DepEd Order No. 16, s, 2012, entitled *Guidelines of the Implementation of the Mother Tongue-Based-Multi Lingual Education (MTB-MLE)*, the field is hereby informed of the **2nd DIVISION MOTHER TONGUE-BASED MULTILINGUAL EDUCATION (MTB-MLE) CONGRESS** on November 18, 2019, 8:00-5:00 p.m. at Jakelou Events Place, Navarro Street, Surigao City.
2. The theme for this year's Congress embeds on "Reclaiming the Right to Learn in One's Own Language" which will be participated by the Kindergarten to 3 Teachers.
3. The congress aims to fully empower the Department's mandates in ensuring that its program as well as projects is implemented with utmost quality, dedication and commitment. It also aims to ensure that the MTB-MLE is administered properly based on policies and guidelines issued by the Department.

7. Each district shall bring a portfolio of accomplishments, big books and other teaching-learning materials produced by implementers for the exhibit.

8. The Criteria for the MTB-MLE Best Practices AVP are as follows:

Technical Organization	30%

Planning and Organization	- 25%
Relevance of Content, Product and Variation of Display	- 30%
Visual Impact of the Display & Neatness	- 20%
