This training is in pursuance to DepEd Order No. 30, s. 2018 known as Preventive Drug Education Program Policy for Curriculum and Instruction in support to the National Drug Education Program or NDEP which is anchored on Republic Act No. 9165 or the Comprehensive Dangerous Drugs Act of 2002 which provides that ***"Instruction on drug abuse prevention and control shall be integrated in the elementary, secondary and tertiary curricula of all public and private schools.....in the consciousness of students."*** Many other legal mandates are pursued by the Education Department, among others, DepEd Order No. 40 s. 2016 on Policy and Guidelines on Comprehensive Tobacco Control, DepEd Order No. 40 s. 2012 also known as DepEd Child Protection Policy and Department Memoranda and other related regulations.
2. To give an overview of the different strategies that the Department is currently implementing in pursuance to R.A. No. 9165, and to strengthen the implementation of Preventive Drug Education Program (PDEP), are the main objectives of this orientation-training which is to be held on November 19, 2019 at 8:00 o'clock in the morning to 5:00o'clock in the afternoon at City Cultural Center, Surigao City.
3. The participants of this activity are the Heads of Schools of all elementary and secondary schools together with their respective school NDEP Coordinators ( List of Participants hereto attached).
4. This Division level training is free of charge to include Lunch, morning and afternoon snacks and training materials. Expenses incurred in this endeavor will be charged against Human Resource Development Fund of the division. Transportation to and from the venue shall be the responsibility of the participants.
