Final Series

The number of rounds in the final series for high school and college shall be determined by the Adjudication Core based on the number of participating teams. The final series may include the following rounds: octofinal (top 32 breaking teams), quarterfinal (16 teams), semifinal (8 teams) and final round (4 teams).

Adjudication

Adjudication shall either be by single adjudication or by panel. The decision of the adjudicator/s shall be final and irrevocable.

Debaters and coaches should never harass or attack the adjudicator/s. Feedback forms shall be provided so concerns can be addressed.

Disclosure of Conflict

Upon filling up the registration form, the adjudicators should disclose the conflict.

Conflict includes, but not limited to, school affiliation, teams being coached or trained, debaters who are relatives (third degree of consanguinity), among others. Adjudicators shall not be allocated to teams with conflict.

Adoption of Other Rules

In the absence of applicable rules, the CPDC shall adopt the rules of the Philippine Schools Debate Championship when other conflicts in the tournament will arise.
